



VACANCY FOR CLINICAL ENGINEERING TECHNICIAN

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The Gibraltar Health Authority invites applications for the post of Clinical Engineering Technician from suitably qualified individuals, who by virtue of their citizenship are entitled to take up employment and who are, or upon employment, will be resident in Gibraltar.

Applicants will be responsible for assisting in the repair, commissioning, preventive maintenance and safety testing of specialist medical equipment and plant across the Gibraltar Health Authority. The post holder will support the safe, efficient and compliant operation of medical devices by undertaking fault-finding, scheduled maintenance, calibration, equipment upgrades, and documentation duties. Responsibilities also include supporting clinical teams through user training, liaising with suppliers, maintaining accurate equipment records, and contributing to service improvements within the Clinical Engineering Department. The post holder will also participate in an on-call rota and may be required to work after normal hours.

The post is permanent, subject to a successful completion of a 12-month probationary period, and carries the following salary:
